What Criteria Must Be Met in Order to be Eligible?

- The Windsong Wolf Spirit Scholarship looks at the eligible candidate as a whole person, recognizing academic achievements, effort, and contributions to the school climate. As such, the eligible candidate must demonstrate overall success.
- Academic Achievement Have a minimum overall academic average of nothing less than a "Progressing" in all subjects.
- A strong indication of academic promise (A solid indication of an intention to continue learning at a post-secondary level after high school.)
- Contribution to the school climate and community through at least one of the following: participation in athletics, school clubs, positive interactions with other grade levels, and community service.
- Student leadership qualities in school activities.

To ensure that your application qualifies, please read the information carefully and follow the procedures outlined in your application package.
