## Jumpstart Accessibility Grant Submission

- Friends of Windsong succssefully submitted on March 16/2018
- Expected Response by June 4/2018
- Two parts funding streams for the grants and they determine your eligibility The inclusion grant is between \$250 000 and \$1 000 000 per project.
  - a. Up to four grants valued at \$250,000
  - b. Up to two grants valued at \$500,000
  - c. Two grants valued at \$1,000,000
